THE IMPORTANCE OF CHOOSING DOG-SAFE TENNIS BALLS

Why should pet parents choose a dog-specific tennis ball? We look at the comparisons to help keep pooches safe during play.

FEATURE	STANDARD TENNIS BALL	DOG TENNIS BALL
 MAIN PURPOSE	Competitive tennis play	Fetch, chewing, and dog play
 OUTER FELT	Rough, abrasive felt for court performance	Softer, non-abrasive felt designed to be gentler on teeth
 CORE AND PRESSURE	Pressurized rubber core for bounce and speed	Often less pressurized, thicker, or made to be more durable
 MATERIALS	Made to tennis-ball standards, not for chewing	Uses pet-safe materials, dyes, and adhesives
 BOUNCE	Consistent, regulated tennis bounce	Variable bounce; designed more for play
 DURABILITY WITH DOGS	Can wear down quickly and shed fuzz	Made to withstand mouthing and rougher play
